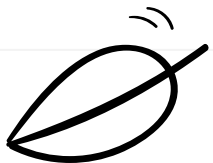
- Classroom Licensed - 20 FTE (decrease of 1.0 FTE)

- Enrollment Projection 490.25 (current enrollment 487)



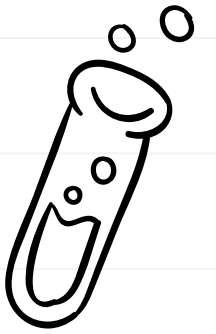

5th Grade	-	81 students

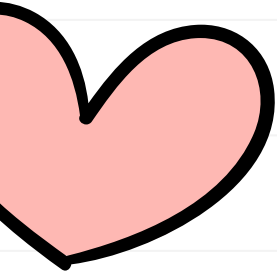


CORONAVIRUS: COVID-19 INFO
